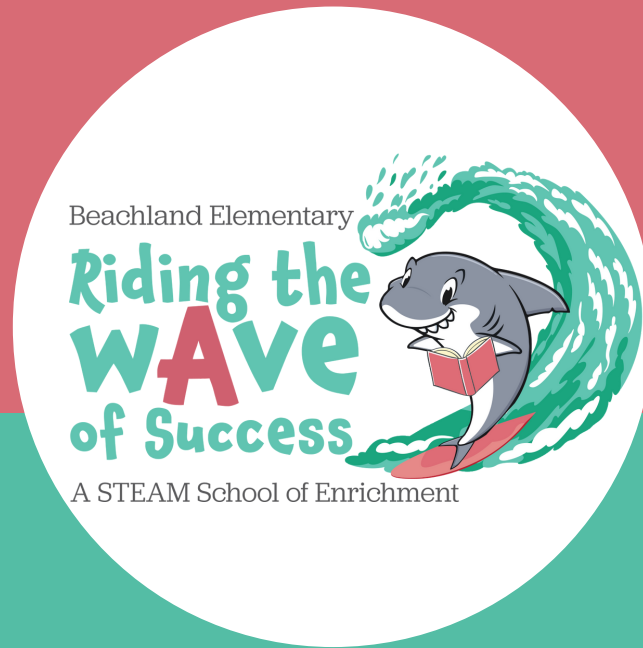

EXTRACURRICULAR PROGRAMS

Art Club:

Book Battle:

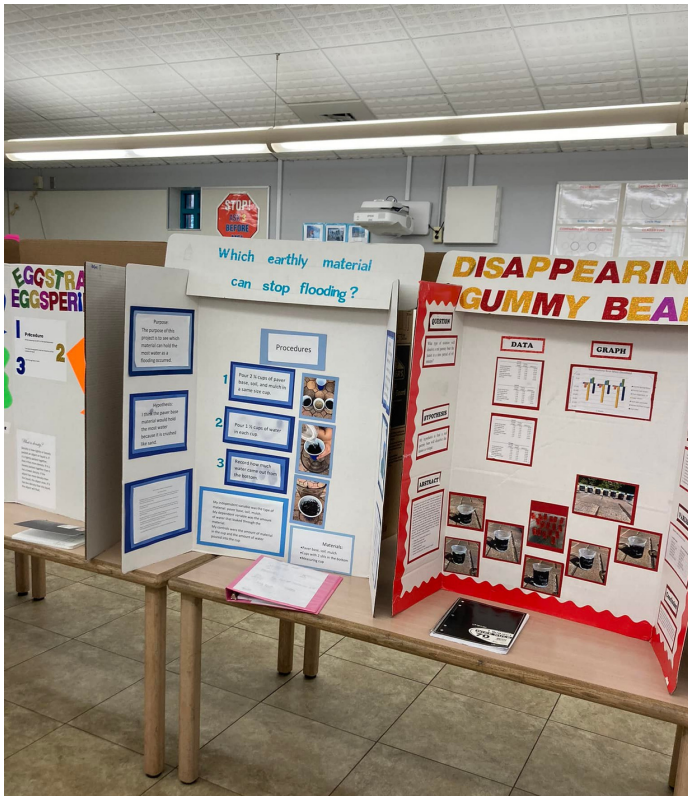
Students read books to demonstrate abilities and test knowledge with peers.

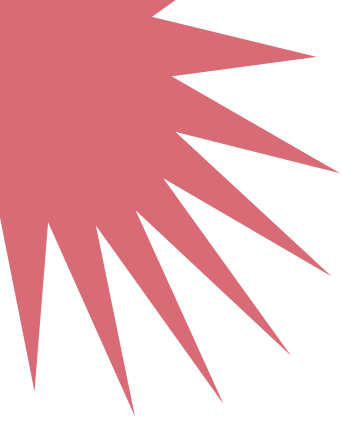
Vex Kits:
