- Almost 80% of people who die from drowning are male.
- 88% of child drownings happen in the presence of at least one adult, according to <u>Stop</u> <u>Drowning Now</u>, a swimming educational platform.
- Drowning is the leading cause of death for children in the United States.
- TEN people drown in the U.S. each day
